

### How to Clear Browser History

#### **BROWSER: FIREFOX**

- 1. At the top, left corner of the Firefox window, click on the Firefox button
- 2. Hover over the History tab and select Clear Recent History



- 3. Select Everything under the Time range to clear drop down menu
- 4. Make sure the following options are checked:
  - a. Browsing & Download History
  - b. Cookies
  - c. Cache
- 5. Click Clear Now





#### **BROWSER: CHROME**

- 1. At the top, right corner of the Chrome window, click on the button with the **three horizontal lines**
- 2. Click on History



#### 3. Click on the Clear browsing data button



- 4. Select **the beginning of time** under the **Obliterate the following items from:** drop down menu
- 5. Make sure the following options are checked:
  - a. Browsing
  - b. Download History
  - c. Cookies and other site and plug-in data
  - d. Cache images and files
- 6. Click on Clear browsing data

### **BROWSER: INTERNET EXPLORER**

- 1. Click on the Tools icon at the top right corner of your IE browser
- 2. Hoover over the Safety tab and click on Delete browsing history



- 3. Make sure the **Preserve Favorite website data** option is **unchecked** and the **following options are checked**:
  - a. Temporary Internet files
  - b. Cookies
- 4. Click on the **Delete** button

Delete Browsing History		
Preserve Favorites website data Keep cookies and temporary Internet files that enable your favorite websites to retain preferences and display faster.		
Temporary Internet files		
Copies of webpages, images, and media that are saved for faster viewing.		
Cookies		
Files stored on your computer by websites to save preferences such as login information.		
History List of websites you have visited.		
Download History List of files you have downloaded.		
Form data Saved information that you have typed into forms.		
Passwords Saved passwords that are automatically filled in when you sign in to a website you've previously visited.		
InPrivate Filtering data Saved data used by InPrivate Filtering to detect where websites may be automatically sharing details about your visit.
